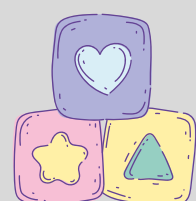
Cisco Networking Academy

Sturgeon Composite High School is now a Cisco Networking Academy. All Division High School students will have access to innovative STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering & Mathematics) courses. Students will be able to complete their CompTIA A+ Certification and begin or complete their CCNA Certification which will give students a competitive edge when entering the workforce or furthering their education with polytechnic schools such as NAIT or SAIT.
