Dear Band Students and Parents.

Please read this letter carefully as it outlines the Jumpstart Field Trip. This field trip is for all students in 6E, 6L. Students should take advantage of this fantastic opportunity!

On **Friday**, **October 4th** (Day 4 for Namao) students new to their chosen brass or woodwind instrument(s) are scheduled for a trip to St. Albert to meet professional musicians! Our main focus will be to learn proper instrument set up, posture for playing, breathing to play a wind instrument, mouth set up, and how to make a characteristic sound all alongside many Sturgeon Students. If you're available to chaperone, have a valid RCMP criminal record check and would like to volunteer, please let me know. We also could use a couple of parent drivers to transport instruments and equipment in their own truck / SUV / trailer / minivan.

Having eaten a good breakfast, students need to meet in the gym at Namao School on Monday, October 4th at 8:30 am. Students will be transported by school bus to and from **St. Albert Alliance Church** (**SAAC**) **200 Villeneuve Rd, St. Albert, AB**. We are scheduled to return to Namao School at approximately 2:40 pm. Students will be required to follow all school rules. The schedule is on the following page.

The risks associated with these activities include tripping / falling, spraining an ankle, injuries associated with playing indoor and outdoor games, and injuries associated with traveling in a motor vehicle. Students will play in instrument groups and as a large band with many other Sturgeon Public Schools students, receive instruction with professional musicians, have a Question & Answer time, play a Showcase of Progress for chaperones and hear performances by professional musicians!

- 8:25 am Meet in Music Room with instrument and backpack (lunch, band folder, pencil, water bottle)
- 8:35 am Reminders, instructions and students help load parent vehicles
- 8:45 Board school bus area & take Attendance
- 9:00 am Depart Namao School
- 9:30 am Arrive St. Albert Alliance Church (SAAC), unload south east side
- 9:45 am Each school will have a corner in the Gym for their own, labeled equipment see GYM MAP
 - Students proceed to their clinic room with instrument in its case, folder & music stand
- 9:55 am Adults can help students find their room see the instrument clinic room / Building MAP
- 10:00 am Students to Sectionals (Clinicians to lead kids to rooms every session)
- 11:00 am Washroom / Snack Break
- 11:15 pm Students return to instrument clinic rooms
- 12:15 pm Students put away instruments into cases, leave equipment in rooms & go to the Gym
