Dear Parents/Guardians,

This year, as part of their options and Social Studies learning this year, grade six students will be participating in a field trip at St. Albert Place on November 28. Our field trip will include:

- Creating Haudenosaunee inspired clay pots
- Creating Greek inspired mosaics

This field trip will allow students to review and extend their understanding of Indigenous Ways of Knowing, and allow them hands-on activities related to Social Studies and Art.

The cost of this field trip, including travel, will be up to \$30, however we would apply \$9.25 from their options fee towards this cost, and we have also applied for a grant through daytrippers. Therefore, a fee of up to \$20 will be added to your child’s account for this field trip. There is **no refund** if your child is unable to attend if they notify us after November 26.

Field trips like this are made available through the help of parent volunteers. **Up to four volunteers with a completed Criminal Record check** will be required for **each** class. Please contact our office should you require a Criminal Record check.

On the day of the trip, please ensure that your child has:

- bagged lunch and a drink

As a school-based activity, students are reminded that school rules apply on this trip. This includes no cell phones.
